Family Treasure Hunting in the Yorkshire Dales

For an alternative fun-filled family activity break in the UK during the school summer holidays, **HF Holidays** suggests its seven-night 'high-tech' [Treasure Hunting](#) holiday in the southern Yorkshire Dales which is suitable for children aged eight and over.
